Route:

Walk past the cart on Garstang Road with it on your right, then turn left up Cock Robin Lane. Turn right up Stone Cross Gardens, past the pebble mediterranean garden on the right and then into the public garden area on the left (marked with a welcome post). Now return to Cock Robin Lane, turn left and then left again past War Memorial to Queen Elizabeth Park. Walk around the park. Do over more than one day if too far for little legs.
